2. To be heard when decisions are made about my parent
3. To be considered when decisions are made about my parent
4. To be well cared for in my parent's absence
5. To speak with, see, and touch my parent
6. To support as I face my parent's incarceration
7. Not to be judged, blamed, or labeled because my parent is incarcerated.
8. To a lifelong relationship with my parent.
